# A new national curriculum was introduced in 2014.



As a result, the Standards and Testing Agency (STA) changed the tests in 2016 so that they assess the new curriculum. Children are not given levels but either meet or exceed the end of year expectations or don't.

# KS1 Assessment arrangements

In May 2018 Year 2, children will take SATs in:

- Reading
- Maths

There is an optional English grammar, punctuation and spelling SAT which we may choose to use to support our ongoing assessments.

# Our response to the changes....

We will continue to assess what pupils understand and can do in a way that supports the whole child.

We will continue to look for progress in the children's learning and teach where the gaps are.

This Summer each child will be given a scaled score from the tasks.

We will report whether your child has met the national standards.



We keep the process for the children very informal in the classroom and talk about 'special booklets'. They love them!!!

Your child's next school are also informed at the end of the year about the outcomes.
